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Many times faster than milling:

# SPLINES WITH SCHWANOG BROACHING RINGS EFFICIENT MANUFACTURE!

The use of Schwanog broaching rings as a serration tool offers great advantages and allows splines to be produced quicker. The splines are completely produced in one stroke – and at a rate that is much faster than conventional milling operations.

Another advantage over milling is the fact that the material can be broached close to a collar, which is technically not possible with milling, due to the cutter diameter.

An undercut at the end of the spline is advantageous, easing chip removal during the reduced

cutting speeds at the end of the feed cycle. Depending on the application, a fixed or moving broaching holder (wobble or reciprocating holder), is required.

Schwanog broaching and shaping tool holders are designed in such a way that a broaching or shaping machine can often be dispensed with. This brings you one step closer to the complete machining of parts on a lathe. The 1° inclined design of the broach/shaping tool holder can reduce the contact force of up to 80 %. This is achieved by concentrating the contact force on a smaller segment of the profile to be broached.



#### The advantages at a glance:

- ☐ Significant unit cost reduction through the use of pressure rings
- □ Production forms are possible very close to the collar
- ☐ Machining mostly possible on the lathe
- □ Reduction of the contact pressure of up to 80 %
- □ Can be used for most materials

#### Important for your production planning:

Part materials (broaching tools) which have a material tensile strength of >1000 N/mm<sup>2</sup> are no longer suitable for broaching operations. There are also limits to the spline depth and machine stability.

Particularly in times of technological change in important branches of industry, and almost daily changes in the world markets, stable parameters for the exchange of information and dialogue are more important than ever.


